

## NOTES TO THE FAMILY

Issue #7, Daily Appropriations, January 20, 2008

**(Psalms 118:24 KJV) This is the day which the LORD hath made; we will rejoice and be glad in it.**

1. **My obligation to love.**

- a. (Matthew 22:37-40 KJV) Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. {38} This is the first and great commandment. {39} And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. {40} On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.
- b. (John 15:12 KJV) This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you.

c. (1 John 3:21-24 NKJV) <sup>23</sup>And this is His commandment: that we should believe on the name of His Son Jesus Christ and love one another, as He gave us commandment. <sup>24</sup>Now he who keeps His commandments abides in Him, and He in him. And by this we know that He abides in us, by the Spirit whom He has given us.

- d. (1 Corinthians 13:4-8 KJV) Charity suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up, {5} Doth not behave itself unseemly, seeketh not her own, is not easily provoked, thinketh no evil; {6} Rejoiceth not in iniquity, but rejoiceth in the truth; {7} Beareth all things, believeth all things, hopeth all things, endureth all things. {8} Charity never faileth: but whether there be prophecies, they shall fail; whether there be tongues, they shall cease; whether there be knowledge, it shall vanish away.

- e. (Romans 13:9-10 KJV) For this, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not kill, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Thou shalt not covet; and if there be any other commandment, it is briefly comprehended in this saying, namely, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. {10} Love worketh no ill to his neighbour; therefore love is the fulfilling of the law.

- f. (1 John 5:1-2 KJV) Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him. {2} By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.

- g.. (Romans 8:26-28 KJV) Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. {27} And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God. {28} And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

**2. Faith, Hope and Trust.** *I am free to love because my fate is in the hands of Jesus.*

- a. (John 14:12-14 KJV) Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do, shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. {13} And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. {14} If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.
- b. John 15:7-8 (NKJV) If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. {8} By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.
- c. (Matthew 16:16-19 NKJV) <sup>16</sup>“Moreover, when you fast, do not be like the hypocrites, with a sad countenance. For they disfigure their faces that they may appear to men to be fasting. Assuredly, I say to you, they have their reward. <sup>17</sup>But you, when you fast, anoint your head and wash your face, <sup>18</sup>so that you do not appear to men to be fasting, but to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you openly. <sup>19</sup>“Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal;
- d. (Philippians 4:6-8 KJV) Be careful for nothing; but in every thing by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. {7} And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus. {8} Finally, brethren, whatsoever things are true, whatsoever things are honest, whatsoever things are just, whatsoever things are pure, whatsoever things are lovely, whatsoever things are of good report; if there be any virtue, and if there be any praise, think on these things.
- e. (2 Timothy 2:24 KJV) And the servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient,

f. (Romans 12:17-19 KJV) **Recompense to no man evil for evil.** Provide things honest in the sight of all men. {18} If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men. {19} Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, **but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.**

- g. (Hebrews 11:6 KJV) But without faith it is impossible to please Him: for he that cometh to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of **them that diligently seek Him.**
- h. (Matthew 6:6 KJV) But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret; **and thy Father which seeth in secret shall reward thee openly.**

**3. My righteousness and favor.**

- a. 2 Corinthians 5:21 (NKJV) <sup>21</sup>For He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

- b. (Psalms 5:12 KJV) For thou, LORD, wilt bless the righteous; **with favour wilt thou compass him as with a shield.**
- c. (1 John 4:4 KJV) Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: **because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.**
- d. (1 John 5:4 KJV) **For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world:** and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith.
- e. (Psalms 37:18-20 KJV) The LORD knoweth the days of the upright: and their inheritance shall be for ever. {19} They shall not be ashamed in the evil time: and in the days of famine they shall be satisfied. {20} But the wicked shall perish, and the enemies of the LORD shall be as the fat of lambs: they shall consume; into smoke shall they consume away.
- e. (Proverbs 21:1 KJV) The king's heart is in the hand of the LORD, as the rivers of water: he turneth it whithersoever he will.
- f. (Proverbs 16:7 KJV) When a man's ways please the LORD, he maketh even his enemies to be at peace with him.
- g. (2 Corinthians 9:7-10 KJV) Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver. {8} And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work: {9} **(As it is written, He hath dispersed abroad; he hath given to the poor: his righteousness remaineth for ever.** {10} Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness;)

#### 4. God's Power and Sovereignty

- a. (Ephesians 3:14-21 NKJV) <sup>14</sup>For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>15</sup>from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, <sup>16</sup>that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, <sup>17</sup>that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, <sup>18</sup>may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height—<sup>19</sup>to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. <sup>20</sup>Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, <sup>21</sup>to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

- b. (Colossians 1:26-27 KJV) Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints: {27} To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is **Christ**

in you, the hope of glory:

- c. (Philippians 2:13 KJV) For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure.

## 5. My Healing.

- a. (Isaiah 53:4-5 KJV) Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. {5} But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes **we are healed.**
- b. (1 Peter 2:24 KJV) Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes **ye were healed.**
- c. (Deuteronomy 7:15 KJV) And the LORD will take away **from thee** all sickness, and will put none of the evil diseases of Egypt, which thou knowest, upon **thee**; but will lay them upon all **them that hate thee.**
- d. (Matthew 11:5 KJV) The blind receive their sight, and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and the poor have the gospel preached to them.-> 11/045/05 evidence that God is not limited-. Nothing missing, nothing broken.

## 6. My Security.

- a. (Isaiah 54:14-17 KJV) In righteousness shalt thou be established: thou shalt be far from oppression; **for thou shalt not fear**: and from terror; for it shall not come near thee. {15} Behold, they shall surely gather together, but not by me: whosoever shall gather together against thee shall fall for thy sake. {16} Behold, I have created the smith that bloweth the coals in the fire, and that bringeth forth an instrument for his work; and I have created the waster to destroy. {17} No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is of me, saith the LORD.
- b. (Psalms 89:18 KJV) For the LORD is our defence; and the Holy One of Israel is our king.
- c. (Psalms 91:1 KJV) He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.
- d. (Deuteronomy 33:29 KJV) Happy art thou, O Israel: who is like unto thee, O people saved by the LORD, the shield of thy help, and who is the sword of thy excellency! **and thine enemies shall be found liars unto thee; and thou shalt tread upon their high places.**
- e. (Psalms 138:7-8 KJV) Though I walk in the midst of trouble, thou wilt revive me: thou shalt stretch forth thine hand against the wrath of mine enemies, and thy right hand shall save me. {8} **The LORD will perfect that which concerneth me**: thy mercy, O LORD, endureth for ever: forsake not the works of thine own hands. -> (For Jesus' sake!)

f. (Psalms 91:9-10 KJV) Because thou hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation; {10} There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.

g. (Psalms 84:11 KJV) For the LORD God **is a sun and shield**: the LORD will give grace and glory: **no good thing will he withhold from them that walk uprightly**.

h. (Proverbs 19:5 KJV) A false witness shall not be unpunished, and he that speaketh lies shall not escape.

i. (Proverbs 19:9 KJV) A false witness shall not be unpunished, and he that speaketh lies shall perish. —> *Speak truth and do not let Proverbs 18:5 & 9 come upon you.*

## 7. My needs and desires.

a. Psalms 23 (KJV) A Psalm of David. The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. {2} He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters. {3} He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake. {4} Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me. {5} Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over. {6} Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD for ever.

b. (Malachi 3:10-12 KJV) Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, **that there may be** meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it. {11} And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts. {12} And all nations shall call you blessed: for ye shall be a delightsome land, saith the LORD of hosts.

c. (Psalms 145:19 KJV) He will fulfil the desire of them that fear him: he also will hear their cry, and will save them.

d. (Philippians 4:19 KJV) But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

## 8. The power in my word.

a. (Matthew 21:21-22 KJV) Jesus answered and said unto them, Verily I say unto you, If ye have faith, and doubt not, ye shall not only do this which is done to the fig tree, but also if ye shall **say unto this mountain**, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; it shall be

- done. {22} And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive.<sup>1</sup>
- b. (Mark 11:23-26 KJV) For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. {24} Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them. {25} And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. {26} But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses. → *a request for forgiveness is not required here.*
- c. (James 4:1-3 KJV) From whence come wars and fightings among you? come they not hence, even of your lusts that war in your members? {2} Ye lust, and have not: ye kill, and desire to have, and cannot obtain: ye fight and war, yet ye have not, because ye ask not. {3} Ye ask, and receive not, because ye ask amiss, that ye may consume it upon your lusts.
- d. (John 16:23-24 KJV) And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you. {24} Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.
- e. (Mark 9:23-24 KJV) Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth. {24} And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I believe; help thou mine unbelief.
- f. (1 John 4:15 KJV) Whosoever shall confess that Jesus is the Son of God, God dwelleth in him, and he in God.

## 9. Fear and me.

- a. (1 John 4:18 KJV) There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love.
- b. (Psalms 23:4 KJV) Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.
- c. (Isaiah 54:14 KJV) In righteousness shalt thou be established: thou shalt be far from oppression; for thou shalt not fear: and from terror; for it shall not come near thee.
- d. (Psalms 118:6 KJV) The LORD is on my side; I will not fear: what can man do unto me?
- e. (Hebrews 2:14-15 KJV) Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood,

he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; {15} And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

f. 2 Timothy 1:7 NKJV <sup>7</sup>For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

g. Exodus 3:11-12 <sup>11</sup>But Moses said to God, “Who *am* I that I should go to Pharaoh, and that I should bring the children of Israel out of Egypt?” <sup>12</sup>So He said, “I will certainly be with you. And this *shall be* a sign to you that I have sent you: When you have brought the people out of Egypt, you shall serve God on this mountain.”

## 10. Blessings

a. (Psalms 100 KJV) A Psalm of praise. Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands. {2} Serve the LORD with gladness: come before his presence with singing. {3} Know ye that the LORD he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture. {4} Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name. {5} For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations.

b. (Psalms 22:3 KJV) But thou art holy, O thou that inhabitest the praises of Israel.

c. (Psalms 67:5-6 KJV) Let the people praise thee, O God; let all the people praise thee. {6} Then shall the earth yield her increase; and God, even our own God, shall bless us.<sup>2</sup>

d. (Psalms 103:2-5 KJV) Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: {3} Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases; {4} Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies; {5} Who satisfieth thy mouth with good things; so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's.

e. (Psalms 122:6-9 KJV) Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: they shall prosper that love thee. {7} Peace be within thy walls, and prosperity within thy palaces. {8} For my brethren and companions' sakes, I will now say, Peace be within thee. {9} Because of the house of the LORD our God I will seek thy good.

f. (Ephesians 1:3-5 KJV) Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ: {4} According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love: {5} Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,

g. (John 10:10 KJV) The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly.

h. (1 Chronicles 16:8 KJV) Give thanks unto the LORD, call upon his name, make known

his deeds among the people.

- i. (Psalms 118:1 KJV) O give thanks unto the LORD; for he is good: because his mercy endureth for ever.

## 11. Wisdom

- a. (Proverbs 7:4-5 KJV) Say unto wisdom, Thou art my sister; and call understanding thy kinswoman: {5} That they may keep thee from the strange woman, from the stranger which flattereth with her words.
- b. (Proverbs 9:10 KJV) The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding.
- c. (Joshua 1:5-9 KJV) <sup>5</sup>No man shall *be able to* stand before you all the days of your life; as I was with Moses, *so* I will be with you. I will not leave you nor forsake you. <sup>6</sup>Be strong and of good courage, for to this people you shall divide as an inheritance the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. <sup>7</sup>Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go. <sup>8</sup>This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. <sup>9</sup>Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the LORD your God *is* with you wherever you go.”
- d. (1 Corinthians 2:9-11 KJV) But as it is written, Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love him. {10} But God hath revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God. {11} For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God.
- e. (1 John 2:27-28 KJV) But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him. {28} And now, little children, abide in him; that, when he shall appear, we may have confidence, and not be ashamed before him at his coming.
- f. (1 John 5:20 KJV) And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life.

## 12. Peace

- (Isaiah 26:3 KJV) Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.
